SENATE BILL NO. 66

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse the counties in
2 Districts 28A and 28B associated with a special primary election conducted on
3 September 12, 2000, and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of seventeen thousand
6 dollars (\$17,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the secretary of state to reimburse
7 Butte, Corson, Dewey, Harding, Perkins, and Ziebach counties for the costs associated with the
8 special primary election conducted on September 12, 2000, in Districts 28A and 28B. Any claim
9 made against the money appropriated by this section shall be submitted to the secretary of state
10 by June 1, 2001, and shall be paid by the secretary of state by June 30, 2001.

11 Section 2. The secretary of state shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw
12 warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

13 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
14 June 30, 2001, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.

15 Section 4. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its

- 1 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full
- 2 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
