## SENATE BILL NO. 78

Introduced by: Senators Kleven, Albers, Brosz, Ham, McCracken, Olson (Ed), Reedy, and Vitter and Representatives Rhoden, Frost, Hennies (Don), Hennies (Thomas), Jensen, McCoy, Pummel, Teupel, and Van Etten

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for increased penalties for exceeding the speed  
2 limit in school zones.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-25-14 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-25-14. When passing a school during a school recess or ~~while~~ when children are going  
6 to or leaving school during the opening or closing hours, the maximum lawful speed ~~shall be~~ is  
7 fifteen miles per hour. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.

8 Any fine imposed for a violation of this section shall be double the usual fine for speeding,  
9 but may not exceed the maximum fine for a Class 2 misdemeanor as provided by § 22-6-2. Signs  
10 showing that any fine will be double the usual speeding fine shall be erected in advance of the  
11 regulatory speed limit signs.
