

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Appointing Mr. Marty Guindon of Pierre, South Dakota, to the office of Auditor-General.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of § 4-2-2, the Auditor-General shall be appointed by a Concurrent Resolution of the State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council has recommended the appointment of Marty Guindon of Pierre, South Dakota, to fill that position:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Seventy-Sixth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that Marty Guindon of Pierre, South Dakota, be appointed to the office of Auditor-General, pursuant to the provisions of § 4-2-2, for the term of eight years from adoption of this Concurrent Resolution, and until a successor is duly appointed and qualified; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Senate of the State of South Dakota transmit an enrolled copy of this Concurrent Resolution to Mr. Guindon, the Secretary of State, and the Governor of the State of South Dakota.
