

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Supporting the designation of U.S. Highway 81 as the Pan-American Highway.

WHEREAS, the Pan-American Highway currently stretches from South America to Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the designation of U.S. Highway 81 in South Dakota would be a fitting continuation of the Pan-American Highway across the State of South Dakota:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Seventy-sixth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that the South Dakota Legislature hereby requests the Transportation Commission to designate U.S. Highway 81 as the Pan-American Highway and further requests that the Department of Transportation and interested local governments, associations, and groups work together to provide the funding for the proper signage of the Pan-American Highway.
