HOUSE BILL NO. 1033

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain registration requirements regarding
2 convicted sex offenders.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 22-22 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 Any person who is registered as required by § 22-22-31 and who is employed, carries on a
7 vocation, or attends postsecondary classes at an institution of higher education, institution of
8 higher learning, or technical institute in this state shall, within ten days of any commencement
9 or termination of such enrollment or employment, report to the chief of police or county sheriff
10 where the institution is located and complete a registration update form. A violation of this
11 section is a Class 1 misdemeanor. Any subsequent violation is a class 6 felony.

12 Section 2. That § 22-22-32 be amended to read as follows:

13 22-22-32. The registration shall include the following information:

- 14 (1) Name and all aliases used;
- 15 (2) Complete description, photographs, and fingerprints;
- 16 (3) Residence, length of time at that residence, and length of time expected to remain at



1 that residence;

2 (4) The type of sex crime convicted of; and

3 (5) The date of commission and the date of conviction of any sex crime committed;

4 (6) Social Security number;

5 (7) Driver license number and state of issuance;

6 (8) Any current or previous sex offender treatment;

7 (9) Employer name, address, and phone number or school name, address, and phone
8 number;

9 (10) Length of employment or length of attendance at school; and

10 (11) Occupation or vocation.

11 Any failure to accurately provide the information required by this section is a Class 1

12 misdemeanor.
