1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to change registration for dental radiographers from tri-
2 annual to annual.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-6A-50 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-6A-50. The Board of Dentistry shall establish and collect fees provided for in this chapter,
6 within the following limits:

- 7 (1) Examination fee for dentists, not more than three hundred dollars;
- 8 (2) Examination fee for dental hygienists, not more than one hundred fifty dollars;
- 9 (3) Annual registration fee for dentists, not more than two hundred dollars;
- 10 (4) Annual registration fee for dental hygienists, not more than one hundred dollars;
- 11 (5) Duplicate license or duplicate annual registration certificate fee for dentists or dental
12 hygienists, not less than five dollars nor more than fifteen dollars;
- 13 (6) Reinstatement fee, an amount equal to the examination fee;
- 14 (7) Continuing education program annual fee of not more than twenty dollars;
- 15 (8) Registration certificate for satellite offices, not more than ten dollars;



- 1 (9) Temporary registration fee, not more than three hundred fifty dollars;
- 2 (10) Annual registration fee for persons practicing dental radiography, not more than fifty
- 3 dollars;
- 4 (11) Examination fee for dental radiographers, not more than fifty dollars;
- 5 (12) General anesthesia, parenteral sedation, and nitrous oxide permits, not more than fifty
- 6 dollars;
- 7 (13) Initial registration fee for persons practicing dentistry, not more than two hundred
- 8 dollars;
- 9 (14) Initial registration fee for persons practicing dental hygiene, not more than two
- 10 hundred dollars;
- 11 (15) Initial registration fee for persons practicing expanded duties, not more than fifty
- 12 dollars;
- 13 (16) Initial registration fee for persons practicing dental radiography, not more than fifty
- 14 dollars;
- 15 (17) Annual registration for persons practicing expanded duties, not more than fifty
- 16 dollars;
- 17 (18) ~~Tri-annual registration for persons practicing dental radiography, not more than fifty~~
- 18 ~~dollars;~~
- 19 (19) Endorsement or credentials fee, not more than six hundred dollars.

20 Section 2. That § 36-6A-53 be amended to read as follows:

21 36-6A-53. As a condition of ~~tri-annual~~ annual renewal of a registration, each registrant shall,
22 on or before the first day of ~~the month in which original registration was granted, every three~~
23 ~~years~~ July, transmit to the secretary-treasurer of the Board of Dentistry, upon a form prescribed
24 by the board, information reasonably related to the administration of a registration system in the

1 interest of public health and safety, together with the fee established by the board, and, in default
2 of providing information or payment of fee, the board may, in compliance with chapter 1-26,
3 suspend the registration of the radiographer during default, but the providing of information as
4 requested and the payment of the fee on or before the date of hearing shall excuse the default and
5 the suspension proceeding shall thereupon terminate. The board may collect the fee by civil
6 action. At least thirty days before the ~~third year~~ first day of July, the board shall cause a written
7 notice stating the amount and due date of the fee and the information to be provided by the
8 registrant to be sent to every registered radiographer. Radiographers shall report the information
9 as a condition of registration renewal, except change in home or office address shall be reported
10 in accordance with § 36-6A-58.
