## SENATE BILL NO. 163

Introduced by: Senators Symens and Diedrich (Larry) and Representatives Peterson (Jim),  
Pederson (Gordon), and Putnam

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the use of certain biodiesel fuel blends.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 10-47B-3 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SUBDIVISION to read  
4 as follows:

5 "Biodiesel blend," a blended special fuel containing a minimum of two percent by volume of  
6 biodiesel fuel oil. Biodiesel fuel oil is a biodegradable, combustible liquid fuel derived from  
7 vegetable oils or animal fats that is suitable for blending with diesel fuel for use in internal  
8 combustion diesel engines.

9 Section 2. Beginning on July 1, 2005, any diesel fuel sold in this state shall be a biodiesel  
10 blend containing at least two percent by volume of biodiesel oil.

11 Section 3. Beginning on July 1, 2007, any diesel fuel sold in this state shall be a biodiesel  
12 blend containing at least five percent by volume of biodiesel oil.
