1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain obsolete provisions regarding time
2 references to central standard time and mountain standard time.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 1-5-5 be repealed.

5 ~~— 1-5-5. Whenever the term "twelve o'clock," "noon," or other designation of time shall occur~~
6 ~~in any legislative bill, resolution, or statute, city ordinance, court record, deed, insurance policy,~~
7 ~~or other contract, or other legal instrument, record, or proceeding, unless otherwise expressly~~
8 ~~stipulated in writing, the time understood shall be, for Gregory County and for portions of the~~
9 ~~state east of the center of the main channel of the Missouri River, central standard time, being~~
10 ~~the civil time of the meridian ninety degrees west of Greenwich, and for other portions of the~~
11 ~~state, mountain standard time, being the civil time of the meridian one hundred and five degrees~~
12 ~~west of Greenwich.~~
