

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to grant counties greater authority to prohibit the use of fireworks during periods of extreme fire danger.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 34-37-19 be amended to read as follows:

34-37-19. Any county may, by resolution, regulate or prohibit the use of fireworks outside the boundaries of any municipality in those areas where the fire danger, as determined by use of the rangeland fire index as established by rule promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26, by the secretary of agriculture, has reached the extreme category in that county during the period from June twentieth to July second, inclusive. During such period, the county's action is suspended if the rangeland fire index falls below the very high category and shall again become effective if the rangeland fire index reaches the extreme category.
