## SENATE BILL NO. 80

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish the Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial  
2 scholarship program and to make an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby established within the Department of Education and Cultural  
5 Affairs the Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship program.

6 Section 2. The Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship program shall be  
7 administered by a five-member board named the Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey Memorial  
8 Scholarship Board which is hereby established. The members shall be appointed by the Governor  
9 for a term of five years, except that the initial appointments shall be for periods of one, two,  
10 three, four, and five years. The Governor shall appoint one member as the temporary chair of the  
11 board. The board shall elect officers at its first meeting. The board shall meet no more than four  
12 times a year, not including telephonic conferences, as may be necessary to complete its  
13 responsibilities as prescribed by this Act. No more than three members of the board may be of  
14 the same political party. At least two members of the board shall be enrolled members of a tribe  
15 located in South Dakota. A majority of the board shall be present either personally or  
16 telephonically to constitute a quorum.



1 Section 3. In order to be eligible for a Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship  
2 award, a student shall:

- 3 (1) Have graduated from a South Dakota accredited high school;
- 4 (2) Have met high school graduation requirements established by rules promulgated  
5 pursuant to chapter 1-26 by the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs;
- 6 (3) Attend a public or nonpublic accredited university, college, or technical institute  
7 located in South Dakota;
- 8 (4) Apply for a Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship within one year  
9 after graduating from high school; and
- 10 (5) Be an enrolled member or the son or daughter of an enrolled member of a tribe  
11 located in South Dakota.

12 Section 4. Scholarship award payments shall be made to the institution at the beginning of  
13 the fall or spring semester on behalf of the eligible student who has received a Richard Hagen-  
14 Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship. The amount of the award is as follows:

- 15 (1) Not less than one thousand dollars for the first year of attendance;
- 16 (2) Not less than one thousand dollars for the second year of attendance;
- 17 (3) Not less than one thousand five hundred dollars for the third year of attendance; and
- 18 (4) Not less than two thousand five hundred dollars for the fourth year of attendance.

19 Section 5. The board may award no more than seven scholarships per year.

20 Section 6. In order to maintain eligibility, a student who has been awarded a Richard Hagen-  
21 Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship shall:

- 22 (1) Maintain a cumulative 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 grade point scale;
- 23 (2) Be continuously enrolled for the fall and spring semesters in a public or nonpublic  
24 accredited university, college, or technical institution; and

1       (3) Complete the equivalent of at least fourteen credit hours of instruction per semester.

2       Section 7. If factors beyond the control of a student who has been awarded a Richard Hagen-  
3 Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship prevent the student from meeting the requirements in  
4 section 6 of this Act, the board may temporarily waive the requirements of section 6 of this Act  
5 as eligibility criteria.

6       Section 8. The Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall provide necessary support  
7 services to the board created by this Act.

8       Section 9. There is hereby continuously appropriated to the Department of Education and  
9 Cultural Affairs any other fund expenditure authority necessary for the department to accept and  
10 expend money the department may receive from any source for the purpose for providing a  
11 Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship.

12       Section 10. The secretary of the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall approve  
13 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

14       Section 11. The Department of Education and Cultural Affairs may promulgate rules  
15 pursuant to this Act and chapter 1-26 to accept applications for a Richard Hagen-Minerva  
16 Harvey memorial scholarship, establish criteria to award a Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey  
17 memorial scholarship, and to maintain eligibility for a Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial  
18 scholarship.
