HOUSE BILL NO. 1015

Introduced by: The Committee on State Affairs at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to permit the Board of Regents to create a multi-institution
2 bonded revenue system.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-51A-1 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-51A-1. Terms used in this chapter mean:

6 (1) "Acquire," includes to purchase, erect, build, construct, reconstruct, complete, repair,
7 replace, alter, extend, better, equip, develop, and improve a project, including the
8 acquisition and clearing of a site or sites therefor;

9 (2) "Board," the Board of Regents or its successor;

10 (3) "Federal agency," the United States of America, the President of the United States of
11 America, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, or such other agency
12 or agencies of the United States of America as may be designated or created to make
13 loans or grants or both;

14 (4) "Institution," includes the following:

15 (a) Black Hills State University, located at Spearfish, South Dakota;

16 (b) Dakota State University, located at Madison, South Dakota;



- 1 (c) Northern State University, located at Aberdeen, South Dakota;
- 2 (d) South Dakota State University, located at Brookings, South Dakota;
- 3 (e) University of South Dakota, located at Vermillion, South Dakota;
- 4 (f) South Dakota School of Mines and Technology, located at Rapid City, South
5 Dakota;
- 6 (g) School for the Blind and the Visually Impaired, located at Aberdeen, South
7 Dakota;
- 8 (h) School for the Deaf, located at Sioux Falls, South Dakota;
- 9 and their branches;
- 10 (5) "Project," includes revenue producing buildings, structures, and facilities which, as
11 determined by the board, are required by, or necessary for the use or benefit of, each
12 such institution, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the
13 following: student residence halls; apartments; staff housing facilities; dormitories;
14 health, hospital, or medical facilities; dining halls; student union buildings; field
15 houses; stadiums; physical education installations and facilities; auditoriums;
16 facilities for student or staff services; any facility or building leased to the United
17 States of America; off-street parking facilities; whether heretofore acquired and now
18 or hereafter used for any or all of the purposes aforesaid, as described in or as may
19 be hereafter acquired under this chapter, with all equipment and appurtenant
20 facilities; or any one, or more than one, or all, of the foregoing, or any combination
21 thereof, for each such institution;
- 22 (6) "Each such institution," includes any institution or any combination of institutions
23 as determined by the board.
