

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to authorize counties to use the South Dakota grassland fire index to regulate the use of fireworks.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 34-37-19 be amended to read as follows:

34-37-19. Any county may, by resolution, regulate or prohibit the use of fireworks outside the boundaries of any municipality in those areas where the fire danger, as determined by use of the South Dakota grassland fire danger index published by the National Weather Service, has reached the extreme category in that county during the period from June twentieth to July second, inclusive. During such period, the county's action is suspended if the grassland fire danger index falls below the very high category and shall again become effective if the grassland fire danger index reaches the extreme category.
