1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the financial incentive for three or more school
2 districts to consolidate.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-6-92 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-6-92. If two or more school districts consolidate after July 1, 2001, and before July 1,
6 2004, the new school district is entitled to an additional three hundred dollars per average daily
7 membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum of four hundred average daily
8 membership from each school district or partial school district as it existed prior to
9 consolidation for the first year after consolidation. If two or more school districts consolidate
10 after July 1, 2001, and before July 1, 2004, the new school district is entitled to an additional
11 two hundred dollars per average daily membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum
12 of four hundred average daily membership from each school district or partial school district as
13 it existed prior to consolidation for the second year after consolidation. If two or more school
14 districts consolidate after July 1, 2001, and before July 1, 2004, the new school district is



1 entitled to an additional one hundred dollars per average daily membership as defined in
2 § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum of four hundred average daily membership from each school
3 district or partial school district as it existed prior to consolidation for the third year after
4 consolidation.

5 If two school districts consolidate after July 1, 2004, the new school district is entitled to an
6 additional three hundred dollars per average daily membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1, up
7 to a maximum of four hundred average daily membership from each school district or partial
8 school district as it existed prior to consolidation for the first year after consolidation. If two
9 school districts consolidate after July 1, 2004, the new school district is entitled to an additional
10 two hundred dollars per average daily membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum
11 of four hundred average daily membership from each school district or partial school district as
12 it existed prior to consolidation for the second year after consolidation. If two school districts
13 consolidate after July 1, 2004, the new school district is entitled to an additional one hundred
14 dollars per average daily membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum of four
15 hundred average daily membership from each school district or partial school district as it
16 existed prior to consolidation for the third year after consolidation.

17 If three or more school districts consolidate after July 1, 2004, the new school district is
18 entitled to an additional four hundred dollars per average daily membership as defined in § 13-
19 13-10.1, up to a maximum of four hundred average daily membership from each school district
20 or partial school district as it existed prior to consolidation for the first year after consolidation.
21 If three or more school districts consolidate after July 1, 2004, the new school district is entitled
22 to an additional two hundred seventy-five dollars per average daily membership as defined in
23 § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum of four hundred average daily membership from each school
24 district or partial school district as it existed prior to consolidation for the second year after

1 consolidation. If three or more school districts consolidate after July 1, 2004, the new school
2 district is entitled to an additional one hundred twenty-five dollars per average daily
3 membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1, up to a maximum of four hundred average daily
4 membership from each school district or partial school district as it existed prior to the
5 consolidation for the third year after consolidation.
