## HOUSE BILL NO. 1162

Introduced by: Representative Hundstad and Senator Dennert

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a four-day school week that school districts  
2 must follow in order to receive state aid to education.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 13-13 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 In order to be eligible to receive general support foundation program funds, a school board  
7 shall set a school week that consists of four school days. The four school days shall include  
8 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. The school board shall also require that all  
9 extracurricular activities take place only on Friday or Saturday of each week of the school term.  
10 Extracurricular activities may not take place on any other days of the school week.

11 For purposes of this section, the term, extracurricular activities, includes all activities that  
12 fall outside the regular curriculum of the school district.

13 Section 2. This Act is effective on July 1, 2005.
