1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to adjust the period of time during which the use of motor
2 vehicle lamps is required.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-17-4 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-17-4. Every vehicle upon a highway within this state during the period from ~~a half hour~~
6 ~~after~~ sunset to ~~a half hour before~~ sunrise and at any other time when there is not sufficient light
7 to render clearly discernible any person on the highway at a distance of two hundred feet ahead,
8 shall be equipped with lighted front and rear lamps as respectively required in §§ 32-17-1 to
9 32-17-26, inclusive, for different classes of vehicles and subject to exemption with reference
10 to lights on parked vehicles as declared in § 32-17-27. A violation of this section is a Class 2
11 misdemeanor.
