## HOUSE BILL NO. 1218

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money for tobacco prevention education  
2 programs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund for fiscal years 2005,  
5 2006, 2007, 2008, and 2009, after the transfer of earnings from the education enhancement trust  
6 fund created in Article XII, Section 6 of the South Dakota Constitution, pursuant to § 4-5-29.2,  
7 the sum of four million five hundred thousand dollars (\$4,500,000), to the Department of Health  
8 for the creation and implementation of tobacco prevention education programs in schools and  
9 communities across the state.

10 Section 2. The secretary of health shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw  
11 warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
