## HOUSE BILL NO. 1238

Introduced by: Representatives Buckingham, Engels, Frost, Konold, Peterson (Bill), Rave,  
and Sebert and Senators Koskan and Sutton (Duane)

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain requirements concerning the rate per mile  
2 that shall be paid when operating certain vehicles on state business.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 3-9-1 be amended to read as follows:

5 3-9-1. ~~It shall be the duty of the~~ The State Board of Finance, on or before the first of July  
6 each year, ~~to~~ shall prescribe a rate per mile which shall be paid to those operating privately  
7 owned ~~motor cars~~ automobiles and vehicles on state business ~~for all departments thereof, which,~~  
8 Any person using a privately owned automobile or motorcycle shall be reimbursed at the same  
9 rate per mile. However, if no state vehicle is equipped for the transportation of a person with  
10 special needs, a different rate per mile may be established. The rate may be changed during a  
11 fiscal year with the prior approval of the Legislative Interim Appropriations Committee. ~~It shall~~  
12 ~~be lawful for the~~ The state auditor ~~to~~ shall issue warrants covering ~~automobile expense~~ vehicle  
13 expenses at the rate ~~so~~ specified by ~~said~~ the State Board of Finance upon the sworn statement  
14 ~~thereof of parties using such car~~ of the party using the vehicle.
