1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain private organizations providing temporary
2 care, shelter, or detention to children to meet certain standards.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 26-7A-23 be amended to read as follows:

5 26-7A-23. A board of county commissioners may provide and maintain at public expense
6 temporary care, shelter, or detention facilities, sight and sound separated from adult prisoners,
7 where children coming within the provisions of this chapter or chapter 26-8A, 26-8B, 26-8C,
8 or §§ 26-11A-13 and 26-11A-14, may, if necessary or appropriate, be placed for temporary care,
9 temporary custody, shelter, or detention as designated by the court, or temporary detention or
10 shelter by the Department of Corrections. Any private organization under contract with a county
11 to provide temporary care, shelter, or detention for children shall meet the standards of care
12 established by the Department of Social Services pursuant to § 26-4-7. Sections 26-11A-19 and
13 26-7A-94 ~~governs~~ govern the costs of custodial care of children.
