3 WHEREAS, Loren Carlson spent his life serving the public; and
4 WHEREAS, Loren Carlson served the Legislature as the first full-time director of the
5 Legislative Research Council from 1955 to 1959; and
6 WHEREAS, Loren Carlson served as South Dakota's first budget director from 1963 to
7 1968; and
8 WHEREAS, Loren Carlson worked in Congress as the administrative assistant to U.S.
9 Senators Francis Case and Joseph Bottum and to U.S. Representative Larry Pressler; and



1 WHEREAS, Loren Carlson was a professor of political science at the University of South
2 Dakota, teaching South Dakota government and politics to hundreds of students, many of whom
3 are now leaders in the State:

5 ninth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that a lifetime of
6 achievement, dedication, and public service be recognized in the person of Loren Carlson.
