SENATE BILL NO. 10

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to construct a
2 computational mechanics laboratory addition to the civil, mechanical engineering building
3 at the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology, to appropriate money therefor, and
4 to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. The Board of Regents may contract for the construction, completion, furnishing,
7 equipping, and maintaining of, including heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer,
8 electric facilities, architectural and engineering services, asbestos abatement, and such other
9 services as may be required to construct a computational mechanics laboratory addition to the
10 civil, mechanical engineering building at the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology
11 at an estimated cost of one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars, to be paid from federal
12 research grant funds.

13 Section 2. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for
14 these purposes from federal sources, gifts, contributions, or any other source, all of which shall
15 be deemed appropriated to the project authorized by this Act.

16 Section 3. The design and construction of the facilities approved by this Act shall be under



1 the general supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided in chapter 5-14.

2 Section 4. The commissioner of the Bureau of Administration and the executive director of
3 the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay
4 expenditures authorized by this Act.

5 Section 5. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
6 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
7 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
