## SENATE BILL NO. 198

Introduced by: Senator Dennert

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Game, Fish and Parks Commission to offer  
2 special buck deer licenses to certain nonresident landowners.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 41-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 If the Game, Fish and Parks Commission provides for special buck deer licenses by rules  
7 promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26, the commission shall, in those rules, provide that five  
8 percent of those licenses are available to nonresident applicants who are landowners in the state.  
9 A nonresident applicant shall own at least one hundred sixty acres of farm or ranch land in the  
10 state to qualify for a special buck deer license. Any license issued pursuant to this section is  
11 valid only on the land owned by the nonresident applicant. No more than two licenses may be  
12 issued to the applicant's immediate family. For the purposes of this section, the term, immediate  
13 family, means the applicant, the applicant's spouse, and the applicant's children. The  
14 commission may, by rules promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26, establish any application  
15 requirements needed to administer this section.
