SENATE BILL NO. 23

Introduced by: The Committee on State Affairs at the request of the Bureau of Personnel

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the definition of a state full-time employee.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That subdivision (12) of § 2-14-2 be amended to read as follows:

4 (12) "Full-time equivalent" or "FTE," a number which designates staffing level where one
5 full-time equivalent position is equal to ~~two thousand eighty paid hours in one fiscal~~
6 year the number of working days in a fiscal year, multiplied by eight hours per day.

7 It excludes: paid overtime hours; hours paid to an employee assigned to a light duty
8 position as approved by the commissioner of the Bureau of Personnel due to a
9 temporary partial disability as defined in subdivision 62-1-1(8); hours paid for
10 accumulated annual leave and sick leave upon employee termination; hours paid to
11 patient employees of the institutions under the control of the Department of Human
12 Services and the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs; hours paid to
13 work-study students enrolled in postsecondary educational institutions or
14 postsecondary students employed pursuant to chapter 3-6B; and hours paid to
15 members of boards and commissions pursuant to § 4-7-10.4. For purposes of salary
16 computation a nine month or more per year full-time teaching or research faculty



1 person, or the equivalent thereof, at the institutions under the jurisdiction of the
2 Board of Regents shall be considered one full-time equivalent;

3 Section 2. This Act is effective on June 21, 2004.
