## SENATE BILL NO. 55

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Health

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse certain family  
2 physicians and certain midlevel practitioners who have complied with the requirements of  
3 the physician tuition reimbursement program and the midlevel tuition reimbursement  
4 program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of eighty-two  
7 thousand four hundred sixty dollars (\$82,460), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the  
8 Department of Health for the purposes of reimbursing two family physicians and one midlevel  
9 practitioner who have, in the determination of the department, met the requirements of the state  
10 physician tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-16A-71.1 or the midlevel  
11 tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-16A-73.6.

12 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state  
13 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

14 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
15 June 30, 2005, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
