1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the membership of the Board of Pardons and
2 Paroles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 24-13-1 be amended to read as follows:

5 24-13-1. The Board of Pardons and Paroles shall consist of nine members. Three members
6 shall be appointed by the Governor; at least one shall be an attorney and at least one shall be a
7 qualified mental health professional as defined in § 27A-1-3. Three members shall be appointed
8 by the attorney general; at least one shall be an attorney. Three members shall be appointed by
9 the Supreme Court; at least one shall be an attorney. Each member of the board shall be a
10 resident of South Dakota and be appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate.

11 Section 2. The provisions of this Act are effective on January 20, 2007, or whenever there
12 is a vacancy in a gubernatorial appointment, whichever occurs first.
