## SENATE BILL NO. 76

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the use of certain documents as a means of  
2 identification.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 1-1 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 No state agency, state supported university, or postsecondary technical institute may accept  
7 a matricula consular card or substantially similar document issued by the Mexican Consulate  
8 as proof of identification for any purpose.
