1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the tuition privileges available to members of the
2 national guard at state universities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 33-6-5 be amended to read as follows:

5 33-6-5. Any member of the National Guard of the State of South Dakota ~~who is a resident~~
6 ~~of the State of South Dakota shall~~ who has not been awarded a baccalaureate degree is, upon
7 compliance with all the requirements for admission; and subject to the provisions of § 33-6-7,
8 ~~be~~ entitled to attend and pursue any undergraduate course or courses in any state educational
9 institution under the control and management of the Board of Regents upon the payment of only
10 fifty percent of the charges for in-state resident tuition. ~~In no event shall eligible national~~
11 ~~guardsmen be entitled to more than four academic years~~ The benefits established under
12 §§ 33-6-5 to 33-6-8, inclusive, are permitted only for course work required to complete the
13 member's first baccalaureate degree. The Board of Regents shall maintain an annual record of
14 the number of participants and the tuition dollar value of such participation.
