1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the tuition privileges available to members of the
2 national guard at state universities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 33-6-5 be amended to read as follows:

5 33-6-5. Any member of the National Guard of the State of South Dakota ~~who is a resident~~
6 ~~of the State of South Dakota shall~~ is, upon compliance with all the requirements for admission;
7 and subject to the provisions of § 33-6-7, ~~be~~ entitled to attend and pursue any undergraduate
8 course or courses in any state educational institution under the control and management of the
9 Board of Regents upon the payment of only fifty percent of the charges for tuition. ~~In no event~~
10 ~~shall~~ However, no eligible national guardsmen be guard member is entitled to more than four
11 academic years under §§ 33-6-5 to 33-6-8, inclusive. The Board of Regents shall maintain an
12 annual record of the number of participants and the tuition dollar value of such participation.
