1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money for the design and construction of an
2 armory.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund the sum of one million
5 one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and three
6 million three hundred thousand dollars (\$3,300,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary,
7 from federal funds available to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs for the design
8 and construction of an armory in Mobridge.

9 Section 2. The amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act are for the following purposes:

10 (1) Armory design, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) from the state general fund
11 and three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) from federal funds available to the
12 Department of Military and Veterans Affairs;

13 (2) Armory construction, one million dollars (\$1,000,000) from the state general fund
14 and three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from federal funds available to the Department
15 of Military and Veterans Affairs.



1 Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act, the Department
2 of Military and Veterans Affairs may accept and expend for the purpose of this Act any funds
3 obtained from gifts, contributions, or any other source if the acceptance and expenditure is
4 approved in accordance with § 4-8B-10.

5 Section 4. The design and construction of this project shall be under the general charge and
6 supervision of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. The money appropriated in
7 section 1 of this Act shall be paid on warrants drawn by the state auditor on vouchers approved
8 by the adjutant general of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs or the state engineer.

9 Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
10 revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
