1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize United States Postal Inspectors to act as law
2 enforcement officers, in certain circumstances, for the enforcement of state law.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 23A-3-24 be amended to read as follows:

5 23A-3-24. For the purposes of § 23A-3-25, the term, federal law enforcement officer, means
6 any officer or employee of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Drug Enforcement
7 Administration, the United States Marshall Service, the Internal Revenue Service, the Secret
8 Service, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, the United States Postal Inspection
9 Service, and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, who is responsible for the prevention
10 or detection of crimes or for the enforcement of the United States Code and who is authorized
11 to arrest, with or without a warrant, any individual for a violation of the United States Code.
