1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions concerning the type of
2 documentation required for the registration of voters.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 12-4-5.4 be amended to read as follows:

5 12-4-5.4. Any person registering to vote shall provide his or her South Dakota driver license
6 number ~~and state of issuance~~ on the voter registration form. If a person does not have a South
7 Dakota driver license, the person shall provide the last four digits of his or her social security
8 number on the voter registration form. If a person does not have a South Dakota driver license
9 or social security number, the person may only register at the county auditor's office and shall
10 sign a statement ~~of such fact~~ verifying the fact that he or she has neither a South Dakota driver
11 license nor social security number. The statement shall be prescribed by the State Board of
12 Elections.
