## HOUSE BILL NO. 1013

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to the Board of Regents for the  
2 construction, remodeling, or renovation of various structures or facilities on the campuses  
3 of the state's universities to provide additional support for women's athletic programs in  
4 furtherance of the policies and objectives of Title IX of the Education Act Amendments of  
5 1972.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

7 Section 1. The Board of Regents may contract for the construction, completion, furnishing,  
8 equipping, and maintaining of, including heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer,  
9 electric facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping, architectural and engineering services,  
10 asbestos abatement, removal of existing roofing and structures, and such other services or  
11 actions as may be required to accomplish, the projects enumerated in section 3 of this Act, all  
12 at the estimated cost of three million, ten thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars.

13 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund the sum of seven  
14 hundred forty-one thousand six hundred three dollars (\$741,603), three hundred twenty-three  
15 thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars (\$323,714) from the higher education facilities fund,  
16 and one million nine hundred forty-five thousand three hundred ninety-seven dollars



1 (\$1,945,397) from other funds available to the universities for the projects specified in section  
2 3 of this Act.

3 Section 3. The projects authorized in section 1 of this Act are the following projects,  
4 together with their pertinent appropriations:

5 (1) At Black Hills State University in Spearfish, South Dakota, projects to upgrade a  
6 locker room, provide office space for coaches, and create practice and competition  
7 softball fields, all for an estimated cost of one million nine hundred sixty-nine  
8 thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars, of which three hundred ninety-six thousand  
9 five hundred forty-five dollars (\$396,545) are to be appropriated from the state  
10 general fund, three hundred twenty-three thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars  
11 (\$323,714) are to be appropriated from the higher education facilities fund allocated  
12 to the university as part of its annual maintenance and repair allocation, and one  
13 million two hundred forty-nine thousand four hundred fifty-five dollars (\$1,249,455)  
14 are to be appropriated from other funds available to the university;

15 (2) At Dakota State University in Madison, South Dakota, projects to upgrade softball  
16 dugouts, acquire portable fencing for the softball field, upgrade the soccer field, and  
17 upgrade locker room space, all for an estimated cost of eighty-five thousand five  
18 hundred dollars, of which thirty-two thousand five hundred ninety-eight dollars  
19 (\$32,598) are to be appropriated from the state general fund and fifty-two thousand  
20 nine hundred two dollars (\$52,902) are to be appropriated from other funds available  
21 to the university;

22 (3) At Northern State University in Aberdeen, South Dakota, projects to upgrade soccer  
23 fields and to provide office space for coaches, all for an estimated cost of thirty-four  
24 thousand five hundred dollars, of which six thousand eight hundred twenty-six

1 dollars (\$6,826) are to be appropriated from the state general fund and twenty-seven  
2 thousand six hundred seventy-four dollars (\$27,674) are to be appropriated from  
3 other funds available to the university;

4 (4) At South Dakota State University in Brookings, South Dakota, a project to upgrade  
5 softball facilities for an estimated cost of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars,  
6 of which one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) are to be appropriated  
7 from other funds available to the university;

8 (5) At the University of South Dakota in Vermillion, South Dakota, projects to renovate  
9 showers and locker rooms, to improve softball fields, soccer fields and their seating,  
10 and to make improvements to the indoor tennis facility, all for an estimated cost of  
11 seven hundred ninety-six thousand dollars, of which three hundred five thousand six  
12 hundred thirty-four dollars (\$305,634) are to be appropriated from the state general  
13 fund and four hundred ninety thousand three hundred sixty-six dollars (\$490,366) are  
14 to be appropriated from other funds available to the university.

15 Section 4. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for  
16 these purposes from federal sources, gifts, contributions, or any other source, all of which shall  
17 be deemed appropriated to the projects authorized by this Act, in addition to the amounts  
18 otherwise authorized herein.

19 Section 5. The design and construction of the facilities approved by this Act shall be under  
20 the general supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided in § 5-14-2. The  
21 commissioner of the Bureau of Administration and the executive director of the Board of  
22 Regents shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures  
23 authorized by this Act.
