1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to define an enrolled student.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 13-28 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 As used in this title, a student is enrolled if:

6 (1) The student is less than twenty-one years of age on the first day of July; and

7 (2) The student has not completed an approved program or graduated from high school;
8 and

9 (3) The student's parent or guardian resides within the school district, or in the case of
10 an emancipated minor, the student resides within the district or the student has been
11 properly assigned to the district or has been approved to attend school in the district
12 under the terms of the enrollment options program established in § 13-28-40; and

13 (4) The student is not simultaneously enrolled in any other school district and has not
14 been excused from school attendance under the terms of § 13-27-1.1 or § 13-27-2.
