1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money to postsecondary technical institutes.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund the sum of six million
4 dollars (\$6,000,000) to the Office of the State Auditor for aid to postsecondary technical
5 institutes. During the months of July and January of the fiscal years 2007 through 2010,
6 inclusive, the state auditor shall distribute seven hundred fifty thousand dollars to postsecondary
7 technical institutes pursuant to the allocation method provided by South Dakota Administrative
8 Rule 24:10:42:28, as promulgated on June 17, 2002.

9 Section 2. The state auditor shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants
10 to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

11 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
12 revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
