1    FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the distribution of contraceptives to public  
2        school students.

3    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4        Section 1. That chapter 13-33A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read  
5    as follows:

6        No person may dispense, provide, or otherwise distribute in a public school or on public  
7    school property, any contraceptive or abortifacient drug, contraceptive device, or other similar  
8    drug or device unless the person is a parent of the student who is being provided the  
9    contraceptive or abortifacient drug, contraceptive device, or other similar drug or device.

10       Section 2. The provisions of this Act do not apply to any school governed by the provisions  
11    of chapter 13-39.



1       Section 3. No person may be adjudicated or prosecuted for a violation of this Act alleged  
2       to have occurred on the property of a public school in which the person is a student.
