## HOUSE BILL NO. 1238

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to purchase certain real  
2 property for the sole purpose of providing a site for the operation of instructional, research  
3 and service programs delivered through institutions established by the Legislature and  
4 governed by the Board of Regents, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an  
5 emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

7 Section 1. The Board of Regents may purchase real property, approximately two hundred  
8 sixty-three acres more or less, located in Minnehaha County from the Department of  
9 Transportation at appraised value. The real property being described as follows: the NW1/4 of  
10 Section 36, Township 102 North, Range 50 West, 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., less Lots H2, H3, H4, H5, H6 and  
11 H7 thereof, and Lot A in the NE1/4 of Section 36, Township 102 North, Range 50 West, 5<sup>th</sup>  
12 P.M., all located in Minnehaha County, South Dakota; Lot C, in the NE1/4 of Section 36,  
13 Township 102 North, Range 50 West, 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Minnehaha County, South Dakota; Lot D, in the  
14 NE1/4 of Section 36, Township 102 North, Range 50 West, 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Minnehaha County, South  
15 Dakota.

16 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of five million eight hundred seventy



1 thousand dollars (\$5,870,000) of other fund expenditure authority, payable from funds donated  
2 and accepted for the purposes of this Act, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board  
3 of Regents for the purchase of the land specified in section 1 of this Act.

4 Section 3. The expenditures authorized by this Act shall be solely for the purposes of  
5 providing a site for the operation of instructional, research and service programs delivered  
6 through institutions established by the Legislature and governed by the Board of Regents. The  
7 Board of Regents may not:

- 8 (1) Organize the programs delivered at this site into a separate degree-granting  
9 institution;
- 10 (2) Erect student residence facilities on the site;
- 11 (3) Construct facilities on the site for use as intercollegiate athletic practice or  
12 competition;
- 13 (4) Establish intercollegiate athletic teams at the site; or
- 14 (5) Sell any portion of the property acquired pursuant to this Act.

15 Section 4. The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the  
16 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

17 Section 5. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
18 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
19 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
