1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the use of state public funds for health services
2 provided out-of-state to medicaid recipients unless the services are not available in state or
3 are required for an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. No state public funds as defined in § 4-4-2 may be used to pay out-of-state health
6 care providers for services rendered to state recipients of medicaid. This section does not apply
7 if the service is not available in the state or if the service is provided in an emergency.
