SENATE BILL NO. 126

Introduced by: Senators Gant, Bartling, Broderick, Duniphan, Moore, Olson (Ed), and Schoenbeck and Representatives McCoy, Fryslie, Glover, Koistinen, and Van Etten

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the state health plan from paying for health care
2 services provided out-of-state except in certain cases.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 3-12A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 The health insurance plan may not cover any service performed out-of-state unless:

7 (1) The service is not available in the state; or

8 (2) The service is required for an emergency occurring outside the state.

9 The provisions of this section do not apply to any retired employee insured pursuant to § 3-
10 12A-18 who lives outside the state.
