1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money to the Department of Public Safety
2 for the coordination of 911 services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund the sum of fifty thousand
5 dollars (\$50,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Public Safety
6 for the coordination of 911 services between the public safety answering points within the state
7 of South Dakota.

8 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety shall approve vouchers and the
9 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this act.

10 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by June
11 30, 2007, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
