1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide compensation to certain retailers for collecting
2 and remitting the sales tax.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 10-45 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 Any person required to file a return and remit the tax imposed by this chapter on a monthly
7 basis and who timely files the return and pays the tax is allowed, as compensation for the
8 expense of collecting and paying the tax monthly, a credit equal to one and one-half percent of
9 the gross amount of the tax due. However, the credit may not exceed seventy dollars per month.

10 Section 2. This Act is effective on July 1, 2007.

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money for enhancement of secondary career
2 and technical education.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby annually appropriated from the state general fund the sum of one
5 million dollars (\$1,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of
6 Education for allocation to school districts to provide funding for secondary career and technical
7 education programs.

8 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Education shall distribute the funds
9 appropriated by this Act to school districts through a competitive grant process. The secretary
10 shall promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to define the criteria used in awarding grants,
11 and to establish grant application procedures and timelines. When awarding grants, the secretary
12 shall give priority consideration to those programs that are innovative or enhanced, that are
13 collaborative efforts, or that include entrepreneurial activities, internships, or career guidance.

14 Section 3. The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the
15 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.



1 Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
2 June 30, 2007, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
