1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the reporting requirements involving sex offense
2 victims.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 22-22 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 If a state's attorney charges a person for a sex offense, as set forth in this chapter, and the
7 offense involves a victim eighteen years of age or older, the state's attorney shall report the legal
8 description of the crime and demographic information regarding the victim of the crime to the
9 Department of Social Services. The reports required herein shall be submitted quarterly to the
10 department in a written or electronic format provided by the department and shall not include
11 the name, address, or social security number of the victim. The department shall maintain a
12 database of such reports and shall make information regarding the incidence and frequency of
13 sex offenses available to the public.
