

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to construct multi-use storage facilities at South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. The Board of Regents may contract for the planning, site preparations, construction, utilities, equipping, and maintaining of multi-use storage facilities at South Dakota State University at an estimated cost of four hundred fifty thousand dollars.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from plant sciences service funds the sum of four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board of Regents to accomplish the purposes of this Act.

Section 3. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any additional other funds obtained for these purposes from federal sources, gifts, contributions, or any other sources, including funds identified in section 2 of this Act.

Section 4. The design and construction shall be under the general supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided by chapter 5-14.

Section 5. The commissioner of the Bureau of Administration and the executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
