## HOUSE BILL NO. 1066

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to initiate a program at  
2 the South Dakota School for the Blind and Visually Impaired to enhance services to children  
3 diagnosed with low vision, to authorize the employment of staff, and to make an  
4 appropriation therefor.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. The Board of Regents may initiate a program at the South Dakota School for the  
7 Blind and Visually Impaired to enhance services to children diagnosed with low vision.

8 Section 2. The Board of Regents may employ such as may be necessary to operate the  
9 program authorized by this Act, and one full-time equivalent position is hereby authorized for  
10 this purpose.

11 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of fifty-seven  
12 thousand dollars (\$57,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board of Regents  
13 to initiate a program described in section 1 of this Act.

14 Section 4. The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the  
15 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

16 Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by



1 June 30, 2008, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
