1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide immunity for school districts in facilitating
2 computer usage.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-24-20 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-24-20. The school board may rent or grant the use of school facilities, including
6 computer usage, motor vehicles, or land belonging to the school district for any purposes which
7 it considers advisable as a community service for such compensation as it determines. The use
8 may also include a contract with a vendor that sells soft drinks or other concessions on school
9 property. The use may not interfere with school activities. Any person or persons or public body
10 using such school facilities, computers, motor vehicles, or land is responsible to the school
11 district for any and all damages that may be caused by reason of the use or occupancy. The
12 school district is not liable for any suit for damages which might arise as the result of such use
13 or occupancy.
