1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the composition of the Commission on Health
2 Care.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 1-7-12 be amended to read as follows:

5 1-7-12. The commission shall ~~be appointed by the Governor and shall~~ consist of no more
6 than ~~twenty-five~~ twenty-seven members. The secretary of health, the secretary of human
7 services, the secretary of social services, and the director of the Division of Insurance shall serve
8 as ex officio members in an advisory capacity. The additional members of the commission shall
9 be representative of each of the following groups:

- 10 (1) Business/employers;
- 11 (2) Consumers;
- 12 (3) Insurers;
- 13 (4) Health care providers;
- 14 (5) Public/community health workers;



- 1 (6) Governor's office;
- 2 (7) Former legislators;
- 3 (8) Tribal members;
- 4 (9) Mental health providers; ~~and~~
- 5 (10) Indian Health Services; and
- 6 (11) Current legislators.

7 The Governor shall appoint no more than twenty-five members representing the groups
 8 described in subdivisions (1) to (10), inclusive. The current legislators on the commission shall
 9 be the chair of the House Health and Human Services Committee, or the chair's designee, and
 10 the chair of the Senate Health and Human Services Committee, or the chair's designee.

11 Section 2. That § 1-7-13 be amended to read as follows:

12 1-7-13. ~~The terms of the members of the first commission shall be:~~

13 ~~—(1)— One-third selected for one-year terms;~~

14 ~~—(2)— One-third selected for two-year terms; and~~

15 ~~—(3)— One-third selected for three-year terms.~~

16 ~~—All subsequent terms shall be for three years. Members of the initial commission are eligible~~
 17 ~~for reappointment. No commission member representing any group described in subdivisions~~
 18 ~~1-7-12(1) to (10), inclusive, may serve more than two consecutive three-year terms on the~~
 19 ~~commission. Persons~~ Any such person appointed to the commission to fulfill the unexpired
 20 portion of a term shall serve for the unexpired portion of that term and may be reappointed for
 21 up to two full three-year terms.

22 A commission member representing subdivision 1-7-12(11) shall serve the two-year term
 23 that coincides with the member's term of office in the Legislature. No such member may serve
 24 more than three consecutive two-year terms on the commission. Any current legislator

1 appointed to the commission to fulfill the unexpired portion of a term shall serve for the
2 unexpired portion of that term and may be reappointed for up to three full two-year terms.
