SENATE BILL NO. 114

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the use of certain addresses by persons signing
2 petitions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. For any petition circulated pursuant to the South Dakota Codified Laws that
5 requires the signer to specify his or her place of residence, a nursing home address, for any
6 person who resides in the nursing home, and a student residence hall address, for any person
7 who resides in the residence hall, is valid and sufficient to meet the requirement to specify the
8 place of residence if the address specified on the petition coincides with the residence under
9 which the signer is registered to vote. A street address is not required for any such nursing home
10 address or residence hall address.

11 Section 2. On any petition circulated pursuant to the South Dakota Codified Laws, a person
12 may sign the petition using the title, Mrs., combined with the name of the person's husband if
13 this form of the signer's name coincides with the name under which the signer is registered to
14 vote.
