1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit advertising chiropractic services without first
2 obtaining a license.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-5-2 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-5-2. Any person who advertises, practices, or attempts to practice chiropractic or who
6 uses the title chiropractor or any word or title having a tendency to induce any person to believe
7 that the person is a chiropractor without first having secured a license from the Board of
8 Chiropractic Examiners or an annual license renewal from the Board of Chiropractic Examiners
9 is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. ~~The state's attorneys shall enforce the provisions of this~~
10 ~~chapter within their respective counties.~~
