1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the fee for certain licenses issued by the Board of
2 Funeral Services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-19-24 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-19-24. Any holder of a license issued by the state authority in any other state maintaining
6 a system and standard of examination for license to engage in the practice of funeral service,
7 which in the judgment of the State Board of Funeral Service, ~~shall be~~ is substantially the
8 equivalent to that required in this state, may be issued such a license after passing a written
9 examination on questions concerning the laws; and rules ~~and regulations~~ of the State of South
10 Dakota upon a the payment of a fee of sixty-five dollars, and upon proof of good moral
11 character the applicable fee pursuant to § 36-19-25.

12 Section 2. That § 36-19-25 be amended to read as follows:

13 36-19-25. A license to practice funeral service shall be issued and ~~shall be~~ is renewable
14 annually upon payment of a fee not to exceed ~~fifty~~ one hundred twenty-five dollars to be fixed
15 by the State Board of Funeral Service.



1 Section 3. That § 36-19-27 be amended to read as follows:

2 36-19-27. An application for a license to operate a funeral establishment shall be submitted
3 for each location and shall be in writing on a form provided by the State Board of Funeral
4 Service and shall be accompanied by a fee not to exceed ~~one hundred~~ two hundred fifty dollars.
5 A license to operate a funeral establishment may be granted upon approval and recommendation
6 by the state board.

7 ~~Such~~ The application shall state the name of the individual who is duly licensed as either
8 a funeral director or in funeral service; and who shall be in charge and responsible for all
9 transactions conducted and services performed ~~therein~~.

10 Section 4. That § 36-19-37 be amended to read as follows:

11 36-19-37. All licenses issued under the provisions of this chapter shall be valid only until
12 the following thirty-first day of December.

13 If a licensee desires a renewal of such license, the State Board of Funeral Service shall grant
14 it, except for cause in compliance with chapter 1-26. All applications for renewal shall be made
15 within thirty days prior to the expiration of the license and shall be accompanied by a renewal
16 fee not to exceed ~~one hundred~~ two hundred fifty dollars, to be fixed by the board.
