## SENATE BILL NO. 79

Introduced by: Senators Lintz, McCracken, and McNenny and Representatives Howie and Pederson (Gordon)

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the boundaries of the Black Hills Forest Fire  
2 Protection District.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 34-35-15 be amended to read as follows:

5 34-35-15. To protect the timber on areas subject to unusual fire dangers, there is hereby  
6 created the Black Hills Forest Fire Protection District, consisting of all that part of the state  
7 described by metes and bounds as follows: Commencing at a point on the Wyoming-South  
8 Dakota state line at the junction of Interstate Highway 90 at the state line; thence east and  
9 southeast along Interstate Highway 90 ~~to Whitewood; thence southeast along the Chicago and~~  
10 ~~Northwestern Railroad right-of-way through Sturgis, Tilford, Piedmont, and Black Hawk to~~  
11 ~~Rapid City; thence south along the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad right-of-way through~~  
12 ~~Hermosa, Fairburn, and Buffalo Gap~~ via Rapid City to the intersection of U.S. Highway 16B;  
13 thence south and southwest along U.S. Highway 16B to the intersection of State Highway 79;  
14 thence south along State Highway 79 to the intersection of U.S. Highway 18; thence south along  
15 U.S. Highway 18 to the Cheyenne River; thence west and northwest along the Cheyenne River



1 to the Wyoming-South Dakota state line; thence north along said state line to the place of  
2 beginning, excepting therefrom areas within the limits of third class municipalities.
