## HOUSE BILL NO. 1166

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the distribution of revenues generated by  
2 Deadwood gaming.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 42-7B-48.1 be amended to read as follows:

5 42-7B-48.1. Disbursements from the Gaming Commission fund shall be as set forth in § 42-  
6 7B-48 until such time as the net municipal proceeds paid to the City of Deadwood equals ~~six~~  
7 ~~million eight hundred thousand~~ six million six hundred fifty thousand dollars for each year, and  
8 after payment of commission expenses pursuant to subdivision 42-7B-48(2), and after payment  
9 of ~~one hundred two hundred fifty~~ two hundred fifty thousand dollars to the State Historical Preservation Grant and  
10 Loan fund pursuant to subdivision 42-7B-48(4). Thereafter, all remaining funds shall be  
11 distributed as follows:

12 (1) Seventy percent to the state general fund;

13 (2) Ten percent to be distributed to municipalities in Lawrence County, except the City



1 of Deadwood, pro rata according to their population;

2 (3) Ten percent to be distributed to school districts, pro rata based upon the previous  
3 year's average daily membership, located in whole or in part, in Lawrence County.

4 For any school district located only partly in Lawrence County, only that portion of  
5 the district's average daily attendance which represents students residing in Lawrence  
6 County shall be considered in calculating the proration required by this subdivision;

7 and

8 (4) Ten percent to the City of Deadwood for deposit in the historic restoration and  
9 preservation fund.
