1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide state aid to education to certain school districts
2 for certain students.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. Terms used in this Act mean:

5 (1) "Eligible school district," a school district that does not receive state aid to education
6 distributed pursuant to chapter 13-13 and that operates a high school primarily
7 focused on career and technical education;

8 (2) "Eligible student," a student who currently attends a high school primarily focused
9 on career and technical education that is operated by an eligible school district and
10 who, immediately prior to attending the high school primarily focused on career and
11 technical education, was enrolled in a South Dakota school district other than the
12 eligible school district.

13 Section 2. That chapter 13-13 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
14 follows:

15 An eligible school district shall receive an amount equal to the per student allocation as



1 defined in subdivision 13-13-10.1(4) multiplied by the number of eligible students included in
2 its fall enrollment as defined in subdivision 13-13-10.1(2A).

3 Section 3. That chapter 13-13 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 The amount calculated in section 2 of this Act shall be distributed to an eligible school
6 district in the same manner as other state aid payments are distributed pursuant to § 13-13-74
7 from funds appropriated in the general appropriations act for state aid to education.

8 Section 4. That § 42-7B-48.2 be amended to read as follows:

9 42-7B-48.2. ~~Notwithstanding any other provision of state law, payments~~ Payments received
10 by a school district in accordance with subdivision 42-7B-48.1(3), shall reduce on a dollar for
11 dollar basis any general state aid otherwise payable to the school district. However, no state aid
12 payments received by a school district pursuant to this Act may be included in that reduction.
